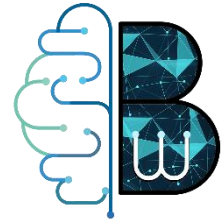

### ABOUT THE EVENT:

Aim of the event is to test the logical reasoning, applicative knowledge and basic understanding of mathematics and science of the participants.

The event will be conducted in 3 rounds:

#### 1st round:

- It will be based on GAME THEORY and aims at testing the participant's deduction and communication skills.
- It is an elimination round and only selected students will be participating in round 2.

#### 2nd round:

- Selected students will be participating in round 2.
- It is aimed at testing the logical aptitude of participants.
- It will be a paper-pen round.
- Questions will be from basic logical reasoning, maths and general knowledge.

#### Final round:

- Selected students will be participating in 3rd round.
- Basic knowledge of science and maths will be useful.
- Format of the round will be told on the spot.

#### Note:

- No specific preparation is required.
- Rules and format of rounds will be told on the spot.
- No specific materials required to bring along with student except student ID card. Any required material will be given by the institute.

## **BASIC RULES AND REGULATION FOR PARTICIPATION:**

- Students from class 9-12th can participate from any recognized school.
- Participation is open for all schools.
- Students need to bring their school ID cards or any other identity proof from school.
- Students will be participating individually. There is no team event between schools or participants.
- Should have maths as subject in 9-10th for basic maths knowledge.
- Conducted in offline mode.
- On spot registration is allowed.
- Replacement of any participant after registration is prohibited.
- All questions and instructions will be given in English.

## **MARKING SCHEME:**

- First two rounds are elimination rounds and students qualifying both the rounds will be participating in final round.
- Any particular marking pattern in the rounds will be told during the event.
- Criteria for judgement in each round will be told during the event.

## **DISCLAIMER:**

- In case of ambiguity, the decision of the judges/organizers would be considered final.
- If any participant found misleading the organiser or using unfair means to win, organiser reserves the right to disqualify the participant at any stage of the event.
- Organisers hold the right to make changes in the event structure during the event.
