ABOUT THE EVENT

This is an event that will challenge the brainiest of students. Challenging puzzles will be given to participants and they have to solve them in given time limit. It is interesting and new way for students to check their logical and mathematical skills, Creativity, and Accuracy.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1) Each team can have a maximum of 2 members.
- 2) The competition is open to all.
- 3) Members should have a valid student ID card of their school/college/institution.
- 4) Use of internet in any form is not allowed.
- 5) Mobile phones should be submitted before start of the puzzle.
- 6) Discussion with other groups is not allowed.
- 7) There will be a total of two rounds.
 - A. **Qualification Round** -
 - It will be a written round.
 - Total duration of Qualification round will be 1 hour 30 minutes.
 - Teams will be given different problems and puzzles to solve in given time bound.
 - Each problem will have some points.
 - Top 6 teams with maximum points will qualify for the Final round.
 - If two teams score the same points, the team which solves more difficult puzzles will be given higher rank. (A team solves 2 difficult questions and B team solves 4 difficult questions then B team will be given higher rank. The difficulty of question will be mentioned on the paper.)
 - All the qualifying teams will be informed within half an hour after conclusion of qualifying Round.

B. Final Round -

- All the rule of final round will be disclosed before the event commences. The round will be of 2.5 hours.
- Top 2 teams will receive prizes.
- Selected teams must be present at the location of event 15 minutes before the commencement of the event so that the organizers can explain the various rules and regulations of the round.

Important note:

1. Main event will be held on 21st /22nd of October.
2. Basic requirements will be made available to participants.
3. The decision of the judges shall be treated as final and binding.
4. The organizers reserve the rights to change any or all of the above rules as they deem fit. Any change in the rules, will be highlighted on the website and notified to the registered participants.
5. All team members will receive Participation Certificate.
