ABOUT THE EVENT

Interesting challenges, intriguing puzzles, and mind-boggling questions are awaiting you. Do you like taxing your mind to solve exhaustive problems and come up with an out of the box solution? If yes, then batten down the hatches to wrestle with time and be the first one to crack a way out. Are you ready for the challenge?

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATION

- 1) Each team can have at most 2 members.
- 2) The competition is open to all.
- 3) On the spot, registration is allowed.
- 4) Members should have a valid student ID card of their school/ college/ institution.
- 5) Use of the internet in any form is not allowed.
- 6) Mobile phones and other electronic devices like calculators should be submitted before the start of the puzzle.
- 7) Basic requirements will be made available to participants.
- 8) Discussion with other groups is not allowed.
- 9) Involvement in any unfair practice will lead to the disqualification of the team.
- 10) There will be a total of two rounds.

A. Qualification Round -

It will be a pen-paper based round.

Teams will be given a set of problems and puzzles to solve in given time-bound.

The total duration of the Qualification Round will be 1 hour 30 minutes.

The questions will have a total of 300 points. The distribution of points will be explained in the question paper.

Top 6 teams with maximum points will qualify for the Final Round.

If two teams score the same points, the team which solves more difficult puzzles will be given higher rank. (A team solves 2 difficult questions and B team solves 4 difficult questions then B team will be given higher rank. The difficulty of the question will be mentioned in the paper.)

All the qualifying teams will be informed within one hour after the conclusion of the Qualifying Round.

B. Final Round -

The rules of the Final Round will be disclosed before the event commences.

The round will be of 2.5 hours.

Selected teams must be present at the location of the event 15 minutes before the commencement of the event so that the organizers can explain the various rules and regulations of the round.

The points scored by the teams in the Qualifying Round shall be considered only in case two teams score equal points in the Final Round.

Top 2 teams will receive prizes.

IMPORTANT NOTE

1. The main event will be held on the 19th/20th of October.
2. The decision of the judges shall be treated as final and binding.
3. All team members will receive a Participation Certificate.
